





## Non-Fatal Shootings by Council District 2022 vs 2023



(%) Indicates comparison of vehicles recovered stolen from each district






## Crime Clearances – NIBRS Category



- Overall crime clearance rates remained relatively similar in 2023 compared to 2022.
- In 2023, 45.6% of crimes against persons and 11.3% of crimes against property were cleared.
- > 34.9% of all NIBRS crimes against persons, property, and society were cleared in 2023.




# Violent Crime Rate Comparison

## Major Cities – Violent Crime Rate Per 1,000 Residents







#### **Domestic Violence**

- ➤ Overall DV crime cases have decreased by 3.1% compared to 2022.
  - > DV cases involving firearms decreased by 3.2%
  - > DV cases involving knives/cutting instruments increased by 15.9%
